Respect for the dignity of all individuals and groups in our nations should be an intrinsic part of our work, in pursuing a culture of peace and wellbeing.

We owe all this to our peoples.

We owe it to the many Maltese-Russian families, that have become an integral part of our societies. The approximately 6,000 members of the Russian diaspora in Malta is evidence of the growing closeness between our peoples.

Let me therefore take this opportunity to commend the Russian Centre for Science and Culture in Malta. I am pleased to note that this institution is providing opportunities, through a variety of events, to give visibility to the Russian culture and way of life.

It is encouraging to see that the peoples of our nations are developing stronger cultural ties through the initiatives taken by the Russian Centre for Science and Culture.

These events, which provide personal interactions, are essential to facilitate greater understanding, respect, and harmony.

Furthermore, I am pleased to note that Malta has become well known within the Russian Federation, as an ideal hub of services and economic activities in the Euro-Mediterranean Region.

Malta's international reputation in the areas of hospitality, aviation, education, transhipment, and the teaching of English as a foreign language, are sectors of potential mutual growth.
